

2011 New Mexico Arbor Day Poster Contest Rules

THEME: Trees are Enchanting . . . Inside & Out!

- ❖ All entries must be original artwork created by a student **currently in the 5th grade** in New Mexico. A student may enter the contest only once.
- ❖ The student's name must be written or signed on the lower right-hand corner on the **back** of the poster.
- ❖ Entries must be no smaller than 8.5" x 11" and no larger than 14" x 18".
- ❖ Artwork may be done in marker, crayon, watercolor, ink, acrylic, colored pencil, or tempera paint. Computer or photo generated art and/or printing is not acceptable. Collages are not acceptable. Do not glue anything on the poster!
- ❖ Entries must be done on paper that will allow for duplication, display, and framing.
- ❖ The poster should reflect the contest theme, and the **theme title must be on the poster**. All words should be spelled correctly.
- ❖ Teachers are encouraged to incorporate the Trees are Terrific curriculum available on the KNMB website. This curriculum enhances your student's understanding of the contest theme and often results in improved artwork.
- ❖ Avoid use of business names or logos.
- ❖ **Each school may submit one poster**. The teacher must complete the School Winner Report Form and attach it to the back of the poster.
- ❖ Entries should be mailed flat and should not be matted, mounted, laminated, framed or folded.
